

The Four Sections and All Streets of Original Overlea

Part of Overlea was annexed by Baltimore City in 1919. *(See the History tab)*
Because of this, some parcels of land and streets are divided between Baltimore City and Baltimore County. If you look at a map of the Baltimore City boundary line, you will see how the line dissects streets and properties.

Overlea (West Side) in Baltimore County

The first five streets are sometimes referred to as “Overlea Manor.”

- Manor Avenue
- West Elm Avenue
- Fuller Avenue
- Highview Avenue
- Taylor Avenue - *(south side only, up to and including part of the MD School for the Blind)*
- Belair Rd/Rt.1 *(from Taylor Avenue to Northern Parkway)*
- Walnut Avenue*
- Chesley Avenue*
- West Overlea Avenue*
- Spruce Avenue*

* In Old Overlea, Spruce Avenue and small parts of Walnut, Chesley and West Overlea are in Baltimore County. These streets are on the west side, and are just south of the streets in “Overlea Manor” along Belair Road (except for Spruce Avenue which is parallel to and a block west of Belair Road.)

Generally, you can tell by the house addresses where the jurisdiction changes: Baltimore County numbers are low (single, double or triple digits) and Baltimore City house addresses begin at 4100 and go lower. The pavement and curb appearance, as well as the street lighting at night, are different.

Overlea (West Side) in Baltimore City *(Old Overlea)*

- A large part of Walnut Avenue
- A large part of Chesley Avenue
- A large part of West Overlea Avenue
- Rosemont Avenue *(to Northern Parkway only)*
- Northern Parkway *(to Walther Avenue)*
- Everall Avenue
- Cedonia Avenue *(to Northern Parkway only)*
- Brook Avenue *(to Northern Parkway only)*
- Ashley Avenue

Overlea (East Side) in Baltimore County

- Fullerton Avenue *(south side only, to Kenwood Avenue)*
- Kenwood Avenue *(inside loop only, starting at Fullerton Avenue, to Mannington Avenue, where the city line starts)*
- Prague Avenue
- Maple Avenue

- East Overlea Avenue
- Willow Avenue to Kenwood Avenue
- Madeline Avenue
- East Elm Avenue
- Linden Avenue
- Beech Avenue
- Third Avenue
- Apple Street
- Cherry Street
- Hazel Avenue
- 1st Avenue
- Willowdale Avenue
- Dale Avenue (*at the Triangle*) to Kenwood Avenue
- Greenwood Avenue to Kenwood Avenue
- 3rd Street
- Belair Road/Rt. 1 (*from Fullerton Avenue to Buck Fowler's Tavern*)

Overlea (East Side) in Baltimore City

- Kenwood Avenue (*inside loop, starting near Mannington Avenue*)
- Belair Road (*at Kenwood Avenue south along the store fronts, to the center of Buck Fowler's Tavern.*) If you sit at the bar in Buck Fowler's Tavern, you are in the county; sit at the tables, and you are in the city - so the story goes!
